

Grouville School Responsible Use Agreement for Children in Nursery, Foundation and KS1

Well-being and achievement are at the heart of Grouville School so that we can all develop as Life Long Learners and take responsibility for ourselves and the community.

As a Rights Respecting School our philosophy is underpinned by the values and principles of the United Nation's Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC).

This is how we stay safe when we use computers and mobile devices at school:

1		I will always follow the rules below when I use computers in school. I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer.
2		I will ask a teacher or adult if I want to use the computers.
3		I will take care of the computer and other equipment. If anything on my computer doesn't work then I will tell an adult straight away.
4		I will only use the Internet when an adult is in the room with me.
5		I will only use activities (such as websites or apps) that a teacher or suitable adult has allowed me to use. If I am not sure then I will check with an adult.
6		I will only search for things that I have been told to search for by my teacher.
7		I will ask for help from a teacher or adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I may have done something wrong.
8		If I see something that upsets me on the screen I will tell a teacher or adult.
9		I will not reply to emails or messages that are from people who I don't know and I will not send any emails that contain my home address or telephone number.
10		My messages will always be friendly and polite.
11		I will not share my password with anyone apart from my teacher and parents.
