Charging Policy for the hire of School Premises

In line with the Education Department guidance, this policy makes clear the charges for the use of the School Premises by the outside users. Charges will be consistent across all outside groups in line with the Competition Law (Jersey) 2005.

Profit making organisations will be charged at the following rate:

- £20.00 per session for the use of the school field, hall or computer area
- £17.00 per session for the use of the field if part of it is also being used by the school

Non-profit making groups, such as the Brownies and Guides will be charged a nominal fee of £20.00 per term.
