• Treasurer's Report

NT shared report from Jon Boleat our Treasurer:

Fundraising events raised a total of: £11,956 last year (compared to £8,905 last year) We spent approximately £994 on these events (compared to £1,622 last year). So, it's a great return of approx. £11,000.

We received a £5,000 grant from the Ana Leaf Foundation for the library. This, combined with surplus funds of £8k brought forward, mean that we have just over £24,000 in reserves to distribute.

We gave our annual donation of \pounds 2000 to the McGugan Family Trust. The PSA has been holding their money, but this has all been transferred to their own bank account now.
