## What information will I receive about my child's progress at school? (Reception-Year 6)

We value parents as partners in your child's education and as such we try to keep you regularly updated regarding your child's progress.

We use a range of assessment methods to make judgements regarding your child's attainment and progress in relation to the Jersey Assessment Framework and Early Learning Goals and these will be shared with you via Parent Consultations as outlined below.

During Parent Consultations teachers will also share your child's progress in respect of other key elements of being a successful learner such as their attitude to school life, behaviour, relationships, organisation and traits of a learner (Successful Learning Ingredients) and for Reception and Nursery this will focus on your child's well-being and involvement and their characteristics of effective learning. You will also be informted of your child's indivdual next steps with their learning so that you can continue to support them with consolidating these skills at home.

We recognise that every child is unique and rates of progress or needs may differ from child to child therefore if your child's class teacher has any concerns regarding your child's progress in relation to their well-being or learning outside of Parent Consultation times, they will liaise with you directly to organise a convenient time for an additional meeting to take place. Equally, we encourage parents/carers to not wait until scheduled Parent Consultations if you have a concen or query regarding your child's progress but to contact your child's teacher in the first instance who will then liaise with the school SENCO to join if needed.

At times throughout your child's journey with us your child may receive some additional support through attending an intervention. If this is the case, you will receive additional feedback regarding specific progress made against their set targets.
