If you look across the road from the main entrance to the school, then you will see blue signs saying "Le Pré Arthur." For any non-Jèrriais speakers, this means "Arthur's Meadow." Arthur McGugan lived up the road from the school. He was, amongst other things, an organic gardener, an outdoorsman and an octogenarian hockey player. Arthur's family gave this land to be used as a forest school in his memory.

Thanks to the Jersey Field Squadron, a boardwalk now meanders two-thirds of the way through the

lush wetlands. This wooden route should be complete by the time the frogs in our meadow pool start to spawn next year.

During pick-up or drop-off, you may notice people working or making use of the Pré. These people could be generous volunteers from Kleinwort Hambros or members of a monthly group helping to maintin the meadow. Maintenance includes looking after the bat and owl boxes as well as the native hedge that you can see from the road. Local Scout groups as well as people from Jersey Mencap are also making use of this facility.

Some of the money raised through the PSA each year is used to maintain Pré Arthur. We are grateful to Maggie Esson for leading and inspiring us in this project. We are grateful to Helen and the rest of Arthur's family for giving this land in his memory. And we are grateful for all the volunteers helping to create fresh memories in young minds as our children get to spend more time in nature.
