

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be learning to...

Play in a group and suggest new ideas.

Invite friends to join in with games and play.

Become aware of our own feelings and the feelings of others.

Solve problems and negotiate with our friends.

Self-regulate our emotions and feelings using the Zones of Regulation.

Communication & Language

We will be learning to...

Retell or play out a simple story.

Anticipate and join in with familiar phrases and rhymes in stories.

Describe how we have completed an activity or created a model.

Answer simple questions about ourselves.

Make plans and describe them to others.

Practice physical communication skills such as pace of speech, volume, projection, posture and eye contact.

Physical Development

We will be learning to...

Maintain our hand washing and drying skills independently.

Explore tools safely.

Use tools such as pencils and scissors with control.

Take risks in our play and learn how to do this safely.

Dress and change with increasing independence.

Move/climb/jump/run with confidence.

Balance using different parts of our bodies.

Literacy

We will be learning to ...

Use our own illustrations or props to retell a story.

Look at books independently and understand that print carries meaning.

Listen out for and play with rhyming words.

Recognise and write some letters from our names.

Engage in mark making during play.



Mathematics

We will be learning to...



Recite numbers to and back from 5.

Subitise up to 3 moveable objects.

Explore how numbers are made up of smaller numbers.

Count objects accurately using 1:1 correspondence.

Make comparisons between different quantities and combine groups of objects to find totals.

Name simple geometric shapes in play and around the environment.

We will be learning to...

Use media, music and materials to express our own ideas.

Construct with a purpose in mind.

Use a resource or materials in a new or unusual way.

Use our imaginations to create new worlds, stories and scenarios.

Understanding the World

We will be learning to ...

Understand job roles in the community e.g. police, fire service.

Explore why and how things happen.

Use technology to find out more about the world around us.
