



Grouville School Traffic Management Plan 2019

UNCRC, Article 19: Children should not be harmed and be kept safe.



Thank you for taking the time to read through these procedures - we are a large school with busy grounds and it is vital that we all work together to keep our children as safe as we possibly can. Please share this with anyone who collects your child.

We ask you to drive sensibly and considerately around the school lanes/ perimeter at all times when dropping off and picking up. We have a large number of families who walk and we need to keep everyone safe.

We have limited parking availability on school grounds so we have developed a system whereby KS2 children can be dropped off and collected from the school gates. Parking for FS and KS1 parents is available on the 'track' by the field along the 'drop off' zone only (please do not park overlapping the pedestrian pathways as these need to be accessible for all pedestrians) or on surrounding roads. We ask you not park on the grass verge on the track. **Please do not park in the staff car park - this is for staff only.**

Please do not park on the yellow lines outside the main gate as this obstructs the view and makes it dangerous for children/ families entering and exiting the school.

We have a part time 'No right Turn' in operation at the end of La Rue de La Haye du Puits on to Rue Maravel from 8:00 to 9:00am and 2:30 to 3:30pm, Monday to Friday. Please filter in turn to maintain a flow of traffic at these busy times. For everyone's safety, please do not park on the pavement at this junction.

Families are encouraged to walk/ scoot and cycle if possible. There is a cycle path from the garage to the Gold Club. Cyclists/ scooterists must dismount when using the road crossing point and when approaching the drop off point/ collection point by the East gate. Storage for bikes and scooters is situated outside the East door.

Start of Day Arrangements

7.55-8.25am "Early Arrivers' Club' to be dropped off from main gate (older children) or escorted in to school by parents. Please do not arrive before 7.55am.

8.25am onwards - KS2 parents to drop off from the East gate. A member of staff will be there to assist. Please drive up to the marked lines to allow 3 cars to drop off simultaneously. Please make sure your child has their belongings ready for a speedy exit from the car. Please sit them on the left hand side for a swift drop off and ensure they do not unclip their seatbelt until the car is stationary. Years' 5 and 6 can be dropped off by the first gate along the track.

Year 1 and 2 parents can escort their children in to the school playground and wait with them until the bell rings. Reception and Nursery children to be escorted to their classroom from 8.30am.

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A member of staff will be on playground duty from 8:25am. Children/ parents should not be on school grounds before this time unless they attend 'Early Arrivers' Club.'

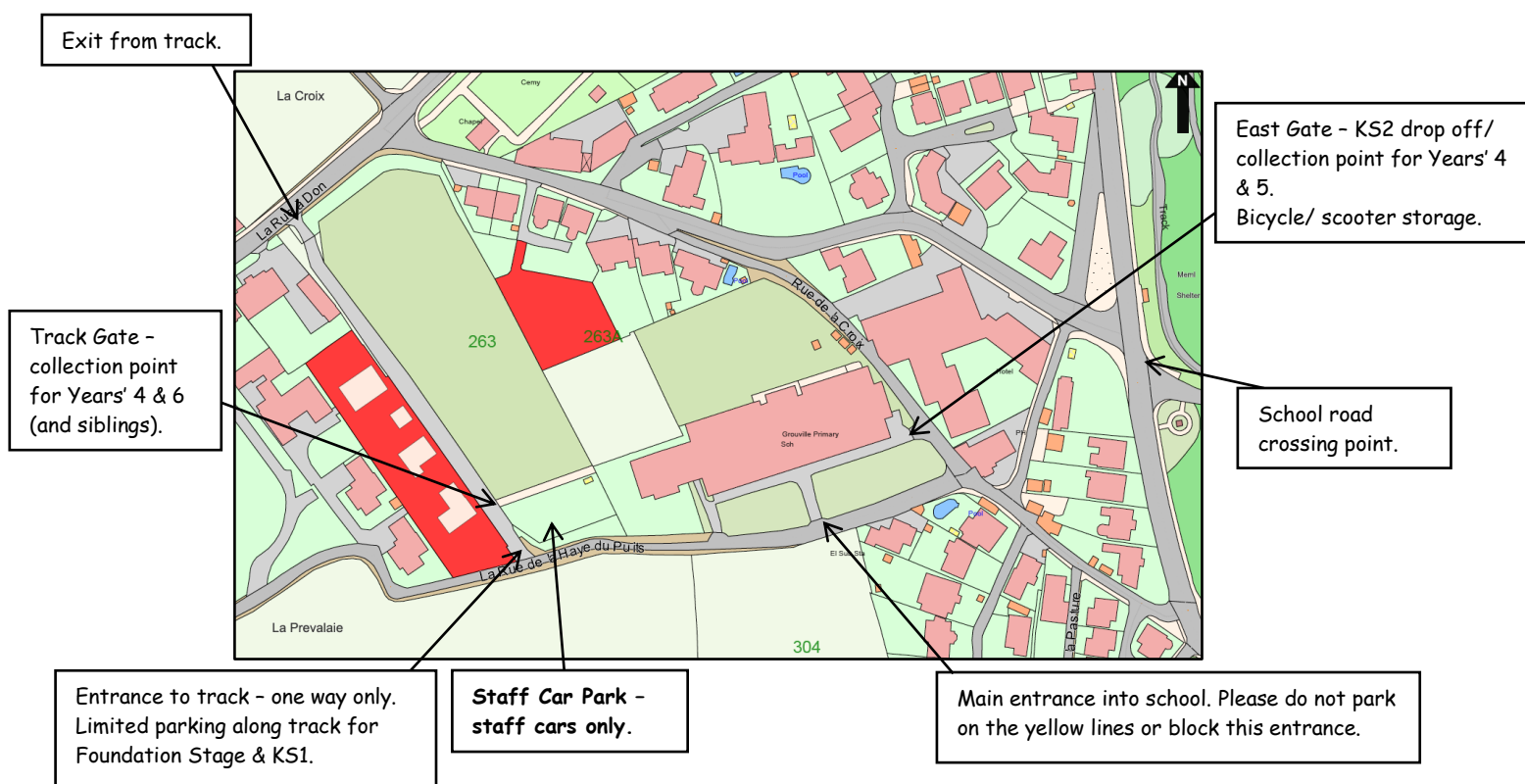
End of Day Collection Arrangements

We have a staggered end of the day in Foundation Stage to help ease traffic congestion. Nursery children are to be collected at 2.30 and Reception at 2.45 from their classrooms (external doors). KS1 children are to be collected from their classrooms (external doors) at 2.55pm. Years 3 & 5 children can be collected from the East gate and Years 4 & 6 (and siblings) from the first gate along the track. A member of staff will be on duty to assist the children. If your child is not ready for you at the gate we ask you to continue around the block to keep the flow of traffic moving.

If you know you are going to be unavoidably delayed then please telephone the school so that we can reassure your child and arrange extra supervision if necessary.

You may give permission for your older children (Upper KS2) to come to and/or from school without an adult, either on foot, by bicycle or by bus. Please provide the school with written permission. A copy of their cycling proficiency certificate is required if they are cycling unsupervised.
