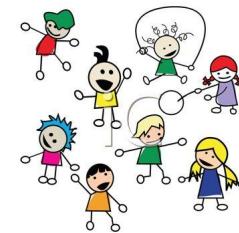
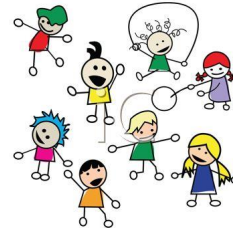
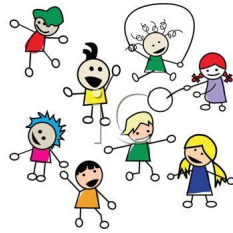
Year One Curriculum

As a **Rights Respecting School** we focus on the rights and wellbeing of the child.

Our right that we will focus on in the first term will be Article 29 – You have the right to become the best you can be.



English

The children will continue learning phonics through daily sessions of Little Wandle and will continue to bring their new book home on a Wednesday.

Our focus this Term is Amazing Adventures, and we will be exploring everything from Space to darkest Peru. Our class Literacy sessions will be applying our phonic knowledge to different texts, so the children develop pleasure in reading a variety of poems, stories and non-fiction books. For our writing we will be leaving spaces between words and using capital letters at the beginning of sentences. We will continue to work on our spellings, punctuation and letter formations.

Maths

We will be learning to work with and count objects reliably to 20 and beyond.

We will count in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will learn more about adding and subtracting bigger numbers. We will be comparing and ordering numbers and looking at number patterns. We will also be using positional language such as first, second etc. and left and right.

Science

Our focus will be learning about sound and hearing.

We will be learning about sound through music.

We will take every chance we can to visit Forest School and develop our scientific observation skills by watching what's happening around us.

Seesaw

We will continue to set weekly homework tasks on Seesaw and will start using Numbots to develop the children's maths fluency.

We will be learning about Jersey our Island home. We will learn to use maps and follow a key. We will be looking at the land use of Gorey.

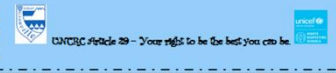


RE

Ingredients for Successful Learning

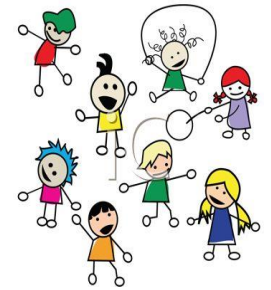
Try, try, try; don't give up.
