



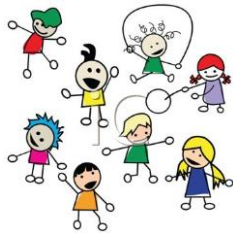

The article we are focussing on this term is **Article 6**

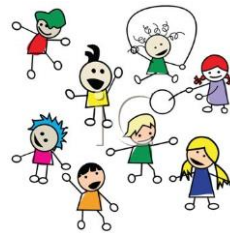
You have the right to life and to be healthy.



English

The majority of children in Year 2 have now completed the RWInc phonics programme and are now doing focussed literacy with their class teacher .

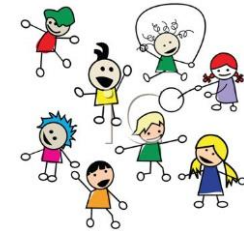
We are following the National Curriculum for English. This term we will be reading a range of non-fiction texts including historical texts. We are also looking at diaries and letters.



Maths

Our focus this term will be multiplication and division concentrating on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will be looking at the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes in geometry.

We will be investigating fractions and measuring the lengths and heights of different objects in and outside the classroom. We will also be collecting information and making bar graphs in statistics.



Computing

Our ICT focus is learning how to use Power point to make our own mini presentations.

We will also be learning how to use search engines. This will be alongside our e-safety learning.

Science

We will be finding out about different plants. We will be identifying some of the different plants in our local area.

We will also be planting some of our own and finding out about the best conditions for growth.

History

We will be finding out about the English Civil War and how the Channel Islands were involved.

We will then move onto looking at the Great Fire of London.

Art

We will be looking at the artist Matisse. We will be having a go at our own art in the style of Matisse.

We will also be looking at how to draw portraits including self-portraits.



P.E. will be on a Monday and Friday.

All children will need to wear full P.E. kit (this includes shorts under their trousers) on both Monday and Friday. If children are able to **tie laces independently**, they may wear lace up trainers.

PSHCE

Our first focus will be looking at Growth Mindsets and how we can develop our own growth mindset.

We will then be finding out about the benefits of a healthy lifestyle and different ways to stay healthy.

Music

In Music we will be continuing our recorder lessons. As part of this please could you make sure your child has their own recorder in school. We will also be looking at the rhythm pace and structure of different genres of music.

Homework

Children will continue with their spelling and reading books.

They will also be given a reading/writing task alongside a maths task each week.
