





You should not be harmed and should be looked after and kept safe.




English

The majority of children in Year 2 have now completed the RWInc phonics programme and are now doing focussed literacy with their class teacher.

We are following the National Curriculum for English. This term we will be learning about poetry, both reading and writing our own. We will also be looking at how to write recounts.

We will continue to focus on improving our grammar skills.




Maths

Our focus in maths this half term will be using place value and number facts to solve problems and finding efficient methods to solve problems.

We will be measuring the lengths and heights in metres and centimetres. We will be using our mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement including turns.

We will be learning to tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour.

We are going to find out about the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.



Computing

This half term Year 2 will have a specialist teaching their ICT lessons. They will focus on following a code and debugging different codes and writing their own codes.

After the half term we will be finding out about algorithms and what they are used for. We will be writing a series of instructions to achieve a goal and we will be using our programming skills to control an external device.

Science

We will be learning about animals, their offspring and their habitats. We will be waiting for eggs to hatch into chicks.

We will also be learning about the importance of a healthy diet and exercise.

Geography

We will be developing our understanding of maps, compass directions and using locational and directional language. We will be drawing our own maps and using keys to understand maps. This will also be linked to our science learning on habitats.

Art

Our art will be linked to our Science work on living things. We will be sketching and making sculptures from nature.

We are hoping to visit the meadow during our lessons to support our art and allow us to make observations *in situ*.



P.E. will be on a Tuesday and Friday.

All children will need to wear full P.E. kit (this includes shorts under their trousers) on both Tuesday and Friday.

If children are able to **tie laces independently**, they may wear lace up trainers.

Please take earrings out on P.E. days.

PSHCE

We will be having a specialist teacher to teach the Keeping Myself Safe and Well lessons. We will also be studying our topic 'No Outsiders' which addresses issues of equality, finding solutions to problems and using strategies to help each other.

Music

We will focus on songs that teach us something. We will be listening and appraising songs about friendship.

We will be consolidating our learning about music and playing the recorders and glockenspiels in parts.

Homework

Children will continue with their spelling and reading books. Please encourage your child to read every day.

They will also be given a maths task each week.
